Prof Akota updated the assembly on the considerable changes made to ADEE's online presence in its response to COVID-19 including a survey and online resources. She also advised of the ongoing plans to deliver online content and summarised some of the online events that were held in advance of the General Assembly:

This included the FEHDD meeting 2020 bringing together a discussion by relevant Oral Health leaders from Academia, Students, the Profession, Research, Public Health and Policy. This session was kindly supported by Colgate.

The 2020 dentistry in society scholarship was presented to Dublin Dental University Hospital (IE), ACTA (NL) and the Faculty of Dental Medicine, Medical University of Sofia following a round table discussion on the concept and aims of the dentistry in society domain. This session was kindly supported by GSK healthcare.
